TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The bidder shall provide free installation of LPG storage tank facilities (30 LPG cylinders, 50kg capacity each). The hospital acknowledges that the LPG installation/equipment and parts are loaned and the supplier is the absolute owner of all said LPG installation/ equipment and part.
 - a. The bidder should also conduct a site inspection and submit scope of work for the installation of its storage tank facilities.
 - b. The existing supplier should allow a 2-3 weeks transition period after the lapse of its contract for the winning bidder to set-up and operationalize its LPG storage tank facilities.
 - c. Provision of aluminum screen for safety purposes and preventive maintenance annually. This covers repair of pipes & cylinders, check up of regulators, and leak testing of cylinders.
2. The hospital and the winning bidder shall schedule the LPG deliveries according to the hospital's actual rate consumption, either weekly or bi-monthly. The supplier shall exercise due diligence in safety maintaining the hospital's LPG fuel supply at adequate level, which shall be determined by the winning bidder in consultation with the OETS and the end-users. The supplier shall deliver upon the hospitals request the needed quantity within twenty-four (24) hours after the supplier confirmed its call/order which should be within twenty-four (24) hours.
3. Prices quoted must include all government taxes (VAT, etc.) fees, impost or duties, if any and all incidental expenses. Dealers/Suppliers are liable for all taxes or duties which may in the future be imposed by the Philippine Government. In case of award, suppliers are required to show proof of payment of all taxes and duties due on the equipment to be supplied or to be sold to the University in compliance with Malacañang Admin. Order #200 dated 21 November 1990.
4. Price of cooking gas shall be fixed for one (1) year.
5. The winning bidder shall deliver the cooking gas in bulk quantity, the volume of which is determined by means of a metering device called "content gauge" installed at the storage container.
6. The hospital shall give the winning bidder a right-of-way for unloading the products any time during regular office hours (Monday-Friday) from 8:00am to 4:30pm. The supplier shall be allowed to enter the hospital premises only upon presentation and proper screening of legitimate credentials for the purpose of delivery, inspection test, maintenance, repair, replacement, and removal of LPG tank & storage container.
