1. Indicate brand, model and country of origin.

- 2. Notarized certificate that the product is brand new, not reconditioned/refurbished including parts and service.
- 3. Delivery and installation should be done within ninety (90) Calendar days commencing on the 3rd working day of notification through confirmed fax that the approved Purchase Order/Contract is already available for pick up.
- 4. Warranty and preventive maintenance should be five (5) years and five (5) years on parts.
- 5. Warranty Period shall commence from the date of acceptance by the end user after installation, testing, and commissioning. And all equipment must be turn key.
- 6. Provide free quarterly preventive maintenance during the warranty period.
- 7. The machine offered must have been demonstrated/evaluated by specific end user heads. A certification by the CCU MAT Head must be included in the bid document.
- 8. The site visit/demo should be the exact machine model to be offered.
- 9. A notarized certification from the manufacturer that the bidder is an authorized distributor of the equipment.
