

TERMS OF REFERENCE

PURCHASE OF DIESEL FOR THE STAND BY GENERATOR SET AT JOAQUIN GONZALES. COMPOUND AND MUSEUM, U.P. MANILA

I. INTRODUCTION

The purchase of the diesel fuel is necessary for the operation of the newly turned over generator sets located at Joaquin Gonzales Compound and Museum building. The generator sets need to be operated once a week to ensure its functionality, reliability, and to keep it in optimum performance in case of power outages.

III. SCOPE OF SERVICE

The SUPPLIER shall supply and deliver a total of 1,350 liters of diesel fuel. The location and capacity are as follows (also see vicinity map Annex A):

The SUPPLIER is required to put the diesel fuel on the Skid Tank of each generator set with the witness of a CPDMO technical personnel.

IV. THE SUPPLIER'S GENERAL RESPONSIBILITY

1. The SUPPLIER shall certify that it has, at its own expense, inspected and examined the PROJECT SITE, its surroundings and existing infrastructure and facilities related to the

- execution of the work, and has obtained all the pieces of information that are considered necessary for the proper execution of the work.
- 2. The SUPPLIER shall provide technical skills and services, personnel, supervision and other related works essential for the proper performance of the activities.
- 3. The SUPPLIER shall provide UP Manila with complete reports and accomplishments.

V. THE IMPLEMENTING AGENCY'S GENERAL RESPONSIBILITY

- The IMPLEMENTING AGENCY, with the assistance of the END-USER, shall provide the SUPPLIER with full information regarding the requirements of the PROJECT.
- The OWNER, through the facilitation of the IMPLEMENTING AGENCY, shall ensure the availability, programming and allocation of funds for the payment of the services of the SUPPLIER.
- 3. The IMPLEMENTING AGENCY shall coordinate with the SUPPLIER, the END-USER and the OWNER in regard to the implementation.
- 4. The IMPLEMENTING AGENCY shall facilitate the proper implementation of the PROJECT, in coordination with the END-USER and the OWNER, in compliance with approved scope of work, implementation schedule, specifications and budget.

VI. FEES AND MODE OF PAYMENT

- a. The approved budget for the contract is **One Hundred Five Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Seven Pesos Only (Php 105,597.00)** for a period of fourteen (14) calendar days.
- b. The SERVICE PROVIDER/ CONTRACTOR shall be paid after providing a service report upon acceptance of the end user and CPDMO.
- c. The ABC is inclusive of all duties and taxes.
