1. Indicate brand, model and country of origin.
2. Notarized certificate that the product is brand new, not reconditioned/refurbished including parts and accessories.
3. Delivery and testing should be done within thirty (30) calendar days commencing on the 3rd working day of notification through confirmed fax that the approved Purchase Order/Contract is already available for pick-up.
4. Warranty period of 2 years parts and 2 years services.
5. Warranty period shall commence from the date of acceptance by the end-user after testing and commissioning.
6. Provide regular quarterly preventive maintenance during the warranty service.
7. Provide a certification issued by the Pediatric Chairman after the item/unit has been demonstrated and/or site visited/inspected and evaluated by the Task force Head
8. A notarized certification of authorized distributorship from the principal manufacturer mentioning the name of the Philippine representative.
9. Notarized certification with proof that the company is in the business of supplying the unit/item for the last three (3) years.
10. Notarized certificate of SEC Registration that the supplier is in the business of supplying medical equipment for at least ten (10) years.
11. Guarantee letter or certificate from the manufacturer and local distributor to ensure the availability of supplies, spare parts, and accessories for the next five years.
12. Provide separate quotation for maintenance, repair and replacement of parts after expiration of warranty for budgetary purposes.
